The members seemed to like the symbolism of the phoenix rising from its ashes as our specialty is devoted to recreating dental health, facial appearance and psychological well-being. In effect giving new life to old faces. I hope we can keep that symbolism even if the phoenix looks like a space age bird."

The six design composites received have been posted to our new Member Forum which can be found on the APC website in the members-only section. They are provided in grey-scale so that we don't get hung up on colour issues right off the bat. Each logo design has been posted to a separate "thread" so that everyone can weigh in on each of the designs. George Albert Zarb gets Triple Crown!

As APCer's can remember, George was one of the founders of our APC. This year he has been triply recognized for his continuing stellar dental career.

On April 4, 2009, the UToronto Faculty of Dentistry's Annual Gala recognized George as one of 4 dentists who have made extraordinary contributions to our profession.

In 2008, The Order of Canada, our highest civilian award, was bestowed on George in recognition of his unique role in the introduction of titanium implants into dentistry. Because of his teaching/travelling commitments, he was not able to be inducted until May 2009. After meeting with Her Excellency the Right Honourable Michaëlle Jean in Ottawa in a very impressive ceremony, George said "It sure makes one proud to be a Canadian."

Then on June 5, 2009, the University of Toronto had its most

prosthodontically impressive convocation ever. George was granted a Doctor of Laws honoris causa, and then he (a prosthodontist) gave the convocation address to the combined graduating classes of Pharmacy, Physical & Health Education, and Dentistry. Two of the 7 PhD degrees conferred were to prosthodontists Dr Limor Avivi-Arber and Dr Sara Al-Fadda. Ceremonially, all 4 of the convocation party were from our Implant Prosthodontic Unit: long time and loyal Implant Surgeon Dr Gerald Baker led as Bedel, IDAPP and IPU Director Dr Aaron Fenton was the Hooder, and prosthodontic faculty Dr Leslie Laing and Jim Anderson were the Esquires. George was retired from UT in 2004, but is continuing his dental career as private practitioner and Editor of the International Journal of Prosthodontics.

COSA/NDSO Update

On April 23rd 2009 representatives from each dental specialty met at the Marriott hotel in Ottawa.

The Committee of Specialist Affairs (COSA), as a committee of the CDA Board, supports the mission and vision of the CDA. The National Dental Specialty Organization (NDSO) represents the interests of each respective specialty. Since the same representatives sit on both committees it is important for the CDA to identify in what capacity an issue is being addressed since COSA can, at times be at variance with the specialty sections. However, the benefit of such a structure is that there has been improved communication and a better relationship between COSA, NDSO and the CDA.

One of the topics that was addressed during the meeting was the unique Identification Number for Dental Anaesthetists.

The national standard uses Unique Identification Numbers (UIN) to enable transmission of claims. Increasing the licensing type was needed to allow identification of anaesthetists within their area and in the CDAnet database and was not available under the current standard. The allocation of UIN to dental anaesthetists raised concerns over the fact that Dental Anesthesia was not a recognized dental specialty in Canada.

CDA officers and staff stated that no new specialties will be recognized until the specialty definition process has been reviewed. Committee members expressed concern on the future specialty definition process and requested a written commitment that COSA would be involved at the onset of the process. The Specialty Definition Review process update is an agenda item for the 2010 COSA meeting.

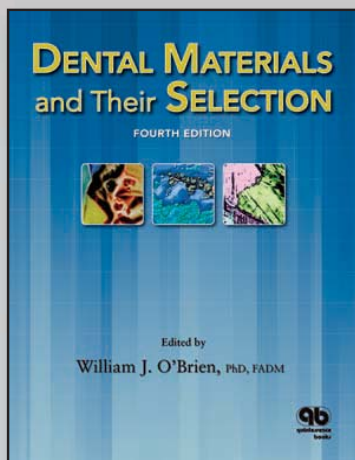

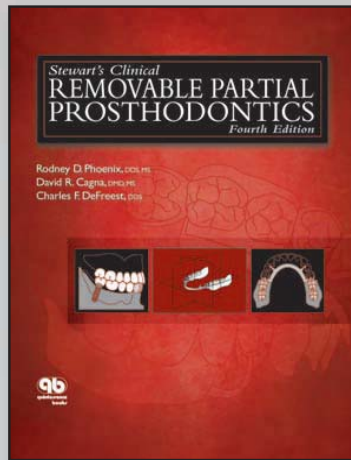


Dental Materials and Their Selection, Fourth Edition

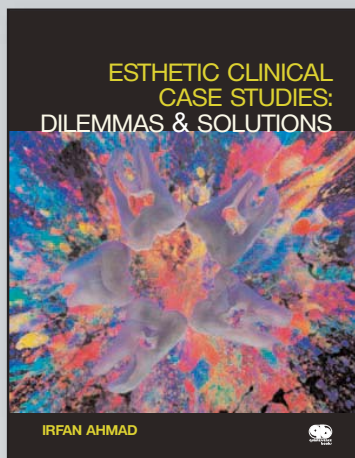


Stewart's Clinical Removable Partial Prosthodontics, Fourth Edition

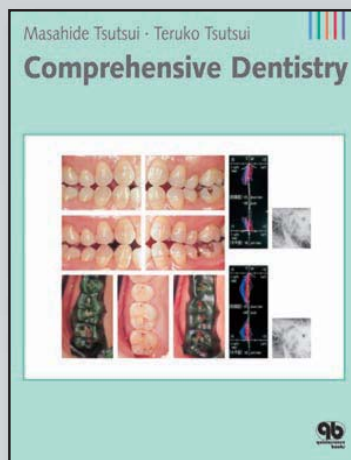
